Construction of the Pohokura gas field has been completed safely and the Pohokura Joint Venture owners, Shell Exploration NZ Limited (SENZL), Todd Energy and OMV NZ would like to say thank-you to all our staff, contractors, suppliers and you the local community for your ongoing support.

Key highlights include:

- Pohokura is New Zealand's largest gas resource
- Construction was completed with no major injuries
- The Pohokura 3 well is New Zealand's longest by nearly 2 kilometres at 7,409 metres
- In a New Zealand first, state-of-the-art engineering means the plant is operated remotely
- 2 kilometres of the offshore pipeline was installed by drilling under the foreshore to avoid damaging the coastal environment. This was another New Zealand first
- The production station's storm water disposal system includes a natural bio-filter of wetland plants
- Drill cuttings were disposed of at a local worm farm, digested and turned into compost
- More than 1,000 people have worked on the project
- Regular community meetings and Pohokura's sponsorship of the Waitara Marine Park.
